



**MINUTES OF  
TOWN OF NORTH SALEM  
COUNCIL MEETING  
DECEMBER 2, 2021**

**1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:**

- e. Beth – Annual Nepotism Forms were given to complete and return; claims were presented to the Board as well as monthly ledger sheets for review and approval.


**6. PUBLIC**
