1. **CALL MEETING TO ORDER:**



5. **NEW ITEMS:**

a. Ordinance 2024-1 – Vacating Public Alleyway. This Ordinance as written vacates the alleyway located between Lot 7 on the north and Lo 6 on the south in Block 6, in Davis and Duckworth’s Addition giving the North half to Mikayla Lawson and the South half to William W. Robinson. Becky made a motion to pass as is; Bill seconded; motion passed unanimously. Second read will take place during the May Board Meeting.

6. **REPORTS:**

- a. Kevin – had no update on the demo on the building that collapsed, however stated that it is now secure with cameras and fencing. Our downtown street lights have been turned off too until this is all taken care of. Everything is good at the plant. We will have a meeting about generators on Monday. We have received one concrete bid for sidewalk repair downtown; working on getting two more. No update on the property on Railroad Street. Kevin will try to touch base with Joe next week.
- b. NSPD – Corey’s report was submitted to Council. The vandalism of the Town Park was discussed. Monetary restitution has been made and it was decided that Community Service was the route to take.
- c. Council – Jimmy suggested that we stone a couple of the “alleys” each year. After some discussion, it was decided that this was an unnecessary expense as most of the “alleys” are grassy and have trees or bushes. The alleys that are used are currently being maintained by the town.
- d. Harold – will review the upcoming state statutes that go into effect in July and will give us a summary of what pertains to North Salem.
- e. Beth – None


7. **PUBLIC**
